



## Changes to CT BOS Policies

**Based on decisions made by the CT BOS Steering Committee on March 15, 2024 the following changes have been made to the CT BOS CoC Policies:**

- The Grievance Policy was amended to include the following language in the section titled “Limitations on Grievances for Providers and Steering Committee Members”
  - CT BOS is committed to ensuring good stewardship of CoC funding and effective use of the resources to end homelessness. This includes ensuring that CoC investments are allocated in a manner that is aligned with the demonstrated needs of people experiencing homelessness. Each year the CoC has the opportunity to reallocate renewal funding to better align investments with needs. The Grievance Committee will not consider Grievances from projects indicating that they could not meet certain performance benchmarks (e.g., occupancy or spending) because there was an insufficient number of people experiencing homelessness who are eligible for the project. Rather, such projects are encouraged to seek referrals from another CT BOS CAN or work with their CAN and the HUD field office to alter their target population and/or reduce the size of the project.
